Catastrophic Injuries

This is defined as any condition in which a student athlete's life is threatened or the student athlete risks permanent impairment. Examples include, but are not limited to, respiratory or cardiac arrest, spine injuries and possible fractures.

Call 9-1-1.

Be sure to have the following information:

- ▶ Name, address, telephone number of caller
- ▶ Number of athletes injured
- ▶ Condition of Athlete(s)
- ▶ First aid initiated by first responder
- ▶ Specific directions to emergency scene:

1: East on SE HOLGATE BLVD toward SE 92ND AVE.

2: Turn RIGHT (or South) onto SE 92ND AVE.

3: Turn LEFT onto SE WOODSTOCK BLVD.

4: Merge onto I-205 S/VETERANS MEMORIAL HWY toward OREGON CITY/SALEM. 2.9 miles

5: Take the SUNNYSIDE ROAD exit - exit number 14 - toward CLACKAMAS.

6: Take the SUNNYSIDE RD. WEST/SUNNYSIDE RD. EAST ramp toward CLACKAMAS PROMENADE/BORING.

7: Turn LEFT onto SE SUNNYSIDE RD. 0.3 miles

8: End at 10180 SE Sunnyside Rd Clackamas OR
