Catastrophic Injuries

This is defined as any condition in which a student athlete's life is threatened or the student athlete risks permanent impairment. Examples include, but are not limited to, respiratory or cardiac arrest, spine injuries and possible fractures.

- ▶ Name, address, telephone number of caller
- ▶ Number of athletes injured
- ▶ Condition of Athlete(s)
- ▶ First aid initiated by first responder
- ▶ Specific directions to emergency scene:

1: Head **south** on **SE 23rd Avenue** toward **SE Nehalem Street**

2: Turn **left** at **SE Nehalem Street**

3: Turn **right** at **SE 24th Avenue**

4: Turn **right** at **SE Tacoma Street**

5: Turn **left** to stay on **SE Tacoma Street**

6: Slight **right** at **SE 32nd Avenue**.

7: Turn **right** to stay on **SE 32nd Avenue** and end at **10150 SE 32nd Avenue**
